

PROGRAM CHANGES:

Spartanburg Community College

- Add a concentration of *Electro-Mechanical* to the existing A.A.S. in electronics Engineering Technology program
- Add an elective track of *Healthcare Information Management and Systems* to the existing A.A.S. in Computer Technology program

Tri-County Technical College

- Extend the A. A., and A.S. programs in General Liberal Arts & Science to the Fred P. Hamilton Career Center
- Extend the A.A.S., Criminal Justice Technology, the A. A. S., Accounting, to the Anderson campus
- Extend the A.A.S., Management with a concentration in Banking and Finance and the A.A.S., Computer Technology with an emphasis in Computer Information to the Anderson campus
- Extend the A.A. in General Liberal Arts & Sciences, the A.A.S., in criminal Justice Technology, and the A.A.S. in Management by offering these programs by 100% Distance Education.

Clemson University

- Change the program name from the B.S.N., Nursing with the BSN-Generic option to the B.S.N., Nursing with a BSN option.
- Add a concentration of *Community Studies* to the B.A. and B.S. in Sociology programs
- Extend the Ed.S. and M.Ed. in Administration and Supervision by blended delivery to several new sites

Coastal Carolina University

- add two tracks to the B.A. in Finance program: *Financial Services; Wealth Management*

University of South Carolina

- add a new blended delivery *Accelerated Concentration* in the B.S.N., Nursing program

University of South Carolina-Beaufort

- add a Certificate in Event Management
- add these four concentrations to the B.A. in Human Services program: *Community Development and Advocacy; Family, Youth, and Child Development, Gerontology, Mental Health and Disability Services*

- terminate the *Sales Electives track* from the A.A.S. Management program

College of Charleston

- terminate the *Discrete Mathematics* track from the B.S. and A.B. in Mathematics program

- terminate the M.A. in Religious Studies program

- terminate the M.Ed. in Elementary Education
