ELEMENT TITLE: Admission Type

SUPPLIED BY: Institution

DEFINITION: The type of admission provided to a degree seeking student upon first entering the institution. This field will be continually updated by the reporting institution. (i.e. a student may be admitted as a Provisional undergraduate initially but as a Regular graduate student later).

CODES, CATEGORIES AND COMMENTS:

P = Provisional
R = Regular
D = Developmental

Provisional: defined as those students who **do not meet** the institution's regular admission requirements and are, therefore, admitted under an **alternative** admission program.

NOTE: Provisionally admitted students (identified by the ADMIT_TYPE data element), entering a higher education institution for the first time, are considered First-time Freshmen by IPEDS. Therefore, these students should be coded 1 (REGIS_STAT) for First-time Freshmen.

Regular: defined as those students who meet the institution's regular admission requirements and are, therefore, admitted under the regular admission program.

Developmental: defined as those students who are enrolled in ~~two~~ **one** or more developmental courses (reported for Technical Colleges only).
