

2012 Prefiled Bills and 2011 Bills Relating to Higher Education

January 5, 2012

The 2012 Legislative Session opens next week on January 10, 2012. This session is the second year of the two-year continuing session of the 119th South Carolina General Assembly.

Below are available summaries of new legislation that has been prefiled for the 2012 session relating to higher education or that may be of interest for higher education.
