Scholarship Enhancement Eligibility Review Committee Meeting

At its meeting on February 5, 2015, CHE approved the [Revised Process to Determine Academic Program and Course Eligibility for Scholarship Enhancement](#). A new feature of the revised process is the implementation of the Scholarship Enhancement Eligibility Review Committee (SEER), which will meet twice each academic year to review institutional applications: once in the fall semester and once in the spring semester. CHE will host the first meeting of SEER on Tuesday, October 6, 2015. Inaugural committee members include the following representatives from each institutional sector and from CHE divisions that service scholarship enhancement eligibility.
