MedTech, Inc. -School Closure

Deadline to Make a Claim: Monday, December 14, 2015 (see below)

TO: Former Students of MedTech, Inc.

SUBJECT: Claim for Refund of Prepaid Tuition

This is to confirm that the postsecondary institution license of MedTech, Inc., formally located at 397 Highland Street, Bethlehem Center, Spartanburg, SC 29306, has been cancelled effective August 28, 2015. Scarlette Johns, owner of the school, informed the Commission that she does not have resources to provide training or to make refunds to students for prepaid, unearned tuition. As a condition for licensure by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education, the school owner secured a bond with the Commission named as obligee. The Commission has notified the bond company of possible claims against the school's bond.

You may be entitled to a share of the bond funds from MedTech, Inc. The funds will be disbursed to the students to whom the school owed refunds. Refund amounts will be based on the prepayments to the school and on the number of hours of training completed. If refunds due to students exceed the funds available, you may not recover fully the refund due to you.
