

Title 59 - Education

CHAPTER 112

Determination of residency for tuition and fee purposes in accordance with SC Code of Laws § **SECTION 59-112-100** et seq and state regulation 62-600 through 62-612.

The Commission on Higher Education may prescribe uniform regulations for application of the provisions of this chapter and may provide for annual review of such regulations.

Residency for tuition and fee purposes: Instate or out-of-state determination	4% Tuition Waivers
Limited exceptions: Military Personnel, Faculty/Staff employed by SC public institutions, retirees, visa- holders,	Act 11: Non-resident veterans and covered individuals receiving GI Bill benefits






Family Share of Public Higher Education Operating Revenues, South Carolina
