### **Pipeline *to* Postsecondary**


- K-12 readiness
- High school completion rates
- Dual enrollment
- Adult education
- Racially/ethnically diverse student population
- Educational attainment gaps among traditionally underrepresented populations

### ***Within* the Postsecondary Pipeline**

- Time to degree completion within 2, 4, 6 years by sector/campus and degree level
- Affordability/financial aid
- Transfer/migration within and among sectors
- Enrollment in remedial courses
- Enrollment in distance/online programs
- Degree completion for traditional students/ adults

Number Enrolled in College by Type of Institution and Attendance Status, All Students, Public and Private Institutions, FT & PT, Undergraduate and Graduate Students



### Grand Total Fall Headcount for All Sectors









■ Part-time ■ Full-time






## Total Undergraduate Headcount by Race/Ethnicity


