- State Appropriations Tied to Performance Measures vs. Student-Driven Scholarship Payments vs. Traditional Fair-Funding Model

Priority #2: Prepare New Higher Education Funding Models/ABF

⦿ Action Items:

- Brief Commissioners on current status of ABF
- Convene university presidents to review accountability-based funding concepts and gauge level of continuing support
- Complete and submit study of institutional funding parity (1/3/2014)
- Complete and submit impact study of year-round scholarship eligibility (12/2/2013)
- Consider strategy to inform/educate legislators on HE bond bill process

Priority #3: Improve P-20 Collaboration

⦿ Issues:

- College Readiness
- Remediation
- Transferability of Coursework
- Effectiveness of Pre-College Initiatives
- Performance Standards & Evaluation Criteria

Priority #3: Improve P-20 Collaboration

⦿ Action Items:

- Create reciprocal engagement of SDE and CHE on each other's boards (MOU by January 2014)
- Increase data sharing with high schools about student performance in college
- Create a P-20 Council upon recommendation of CAAL (January 2014 agenda item for CAAL)
- Request CHE ED to meet quarterly with SDE Superintendent

Creating a Unified Action Agenda

- ◎ Common Themes across the Four Priorities:
 - Clarify uniform standards, criteria, & required data
 - Audit program performance against objective standards & criteria based on data
 - Streamline CHE processes
 - Prepare regulatory changes in 2014 for legislative approval in 2015
 - Improve communication at all levels
 - Improve dissemination of performance data

Marching Orders

- Mobilize CHE staff to support priorities
- Develop strategies that allow CHE re-organization to address these priorities
- Submit monthly reports (December 2013 - May 2014) to assess progress
- Assign priorities to appropriate units of the Leadership Team
- Provide appropriate resources to ED, who is responsible for all deliverables
