The Commission on Higher Education's Committee on Academic Affairs and Licensing met in Columbia today prior to the full Commission meeting. Members voted unanimously to defer consideration of the application of InfiLaw Corporation for initial license to operate the Charleston School of Law (CSOL).

Members voted to defer consideration until May 19, when the Committee will hold a special meeting to vote on the license application. The Committee would then bring its recommendation forward for consideration by the full Commission at its next regularly scheduled meeting on June 5.

Prior to its May 19 meeting, committee members have asked to review all source materials related to the application, including all letters submitted by CSOL students, alumni, and other interested parties.

Committee members have also asked that two public hearings be held before June 5 to provide a final opportunity for input. Details on those arrangements will be announced soon.
