South Carolina Commission on Higher Education Welcomes New Commissioners and Announces Its New Location Effective September 1

The South Carolina Commission on Higher Education announced today Governor Haley's recent appointments to the Commission.

Dr. Jennifer B. Settlemyer from Prosperity and Ms. Elizabeth Jackson from Lexington, who are the Governor's Appointments at Large. The Honorable Lewis Vaughn from Greer fills the Governor's appointment from the 4th Congressional District, Mr. Kim Phillips of Gaffney is the Governor's appointee from the 5th Congressional District, and Mr. Hood Temple was appointed to a second term from the 6th Congressional District.
