The Commission on Higher Education announced today Governor Sanford's appointment of its newest member, Dr. Raghu Korrapati of Columbia, South Carolina. Representing the 2nd Congressional District, Dr. Korrapati is Director of the Property and Casualty Division at the Computer Sciences Corporation.

Dr. Korrapati has earned a Ph.D. degree in Computer Information Systems, an M.B.A. in Business Administration, an M.S. in Computer Science, an M.
