South Carolina Commission on Higher Education Welcomes New Commissioner

The South Carolina Commission on Higher Education announced today Governor Sanford's appointment of its newest member, Mr. Guy C. Tarrant of Charleston. He will serve as a statewide at large appointee for a four-year term.

Mr. Tarrant is the President of The Tarrant Co., Inc., a real estate brokerage firm, and the managing member of Tarrant Properties, LLC, a real estate investment firm. He graduated from Clemson University with a B.S. degree in Industrial Management and also attended the Louisiana State University Banking School of the South.

Mr. Tarrant has served on a number of boards including service for eight years on the Charleston County Planning Board where he was chairman for four of those years. He also served on the Area Commission for Technical and Comprehensive Education for Berkeley, Charleston, and Dorchester Counties for nine years and on the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education for six years. Mr. Tarrant presently serves on the Episcopal Diocese Housing Authority. He is the recipient of the Distinguished Service Award from the Arthritis Foundation of South Carolina.

Married to the former Teresa Jenkins of Columbia, the Tarrants have two sons and two grandchildren.
