2016 Annual Report on the Academic Common Market Program

Established in 1974 by the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB), the Academic Common Market program was designed “to share between states specified degree programs located at southern public colleges and universities through an exchange of students across borders at in-state rates.” As a cooperative agreement among states, the Academic Common Market seeks to eliminate unnecessary duplication of degree programs among states while supporting programs that are able to serve additional students.

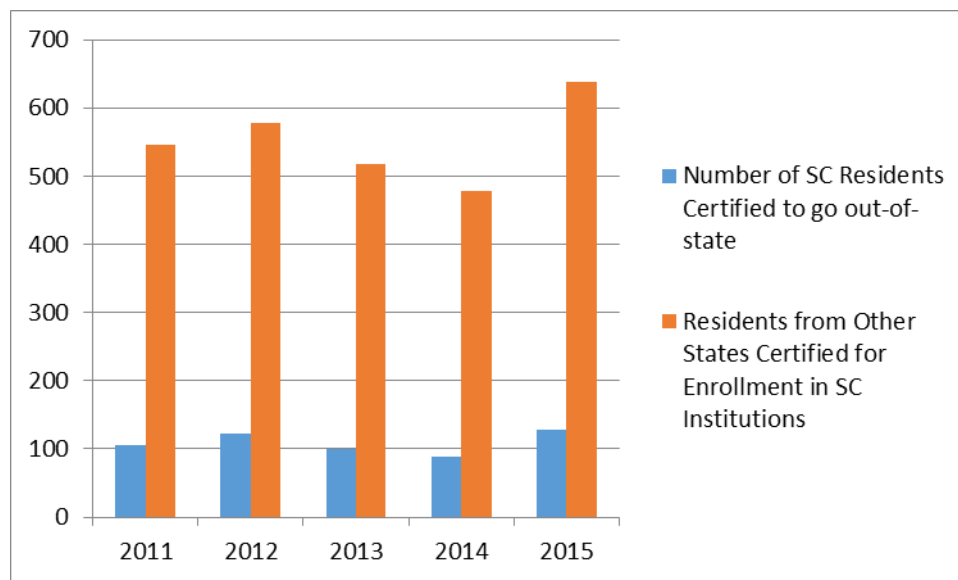
Each participating state compiles its own list of programs for access by its residents. Eligible programs are undergraduate and graduate programs which are at least 50 percent different in course content from programs offered in the home state. Concentrations, options, tracks, or specialization within more general (and otherwise ineligible) degree programs must be extraordinary, specific, and structured to merit eligibility for the Academic Common Market. In South Carolina, the Academic Common Market institutional coordinators at all the public institutions are asked to review new program nominations as well as currently available programs before a decision is made by the institution to include a program. Students can request consideration for inclusion of additional programs throughout the year.

In South Carolina, interested students must contact the Commission on Higher Education for access to the Academic Common Market (ACM). This process involves two steps. First, Commission staff determines whether the student has satisfied South Carolina residency provisions including the required **one-year** period of residency in the state pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws for Determination of Rates of Tuition and Fees and related regulations. Secondly, the Commission staff must verify that the student is fully admitted to one of the specific programs to which South Carolina residents have ACM access. Once a student is certified as having met the eligibility requirements, the student retains ACM status as long as he or she remains enrolled full-time in the same degree program and retains South Carolina residency.

Information about ACM is accessible on the Commission’s website and also on SREB’s website (www.sreb.org). To advertise this valuable program, the ACM program information was transmitted electronically this spring to over 250 high school guidance counselors.

In 2015, South Carolina certified 128 state residents to matriculate to other SREB states, an increase of 40 certifications compared to the 88 students certified in 2014, equaling a 45% increase. During the same period, 639 students from other states were certified for ACM programs at South Carolina institutions. As seen in the Figure 1, South Carolina continues to recruit into the state more students than it certifies to attend an out-of-state institution, and this number increased by 160 certifications during 2015, equaling a 33.4% gain over the 479 total in 2014. Requirements for certification have not changed, and discussions about this increase with representatives at SREB yielded no discernible reasons for the marked increase in demand both out-of-state but especially in-state. Indeed, 2015 student certifications both into the state and out-of-state were at their highest levels in the most recent five years (Figure 1). Details of the annual certifications for all participating SREB states are provided by State of Enrollment in **Attachment I** and by State of Residency in **Attachment II**. Important to note is that the data reflects the number of new students *certified* during the year, not the actual number of the certified students who ultimately decided to enroll in an ACM program.

Figure 1: ACM Certification by Year, 2011-2015



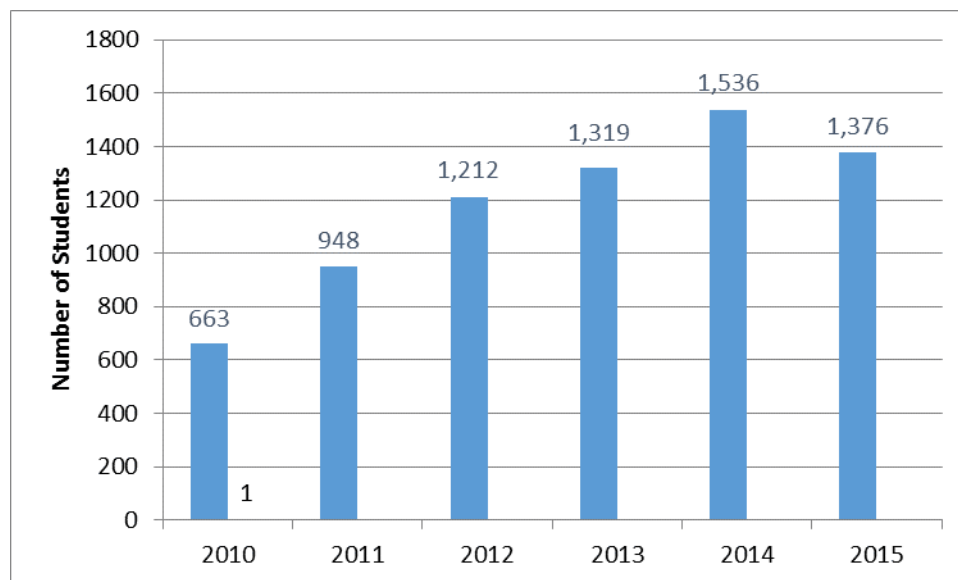
In 2015, the majority of South Carolina ACM students were certified for programs in Tennessee (48) and Florida (15). The two most requested programs by South Carolina applicants were the Aerospace and Aerospace Engineering programs (20 certifications, up from 11 in 2014, an 82% increase) offered at various institutions in Alabama, Mississippi, Tennessee, Oklahoma, and Virginia; and the Recording Industry Program at Middle Tennessee State University (7 certifications). Since discussion about the popularity of aerospace engineering during the 2015

review of ACM data, Commission staff have met with aerospace educators about the interest to offer more aerospace engineering and aviation-related academic programs in South Carolina.

Though the number of certifications into the state increased in 2015 as compared to 2014 as noted (+160), in fall 2015, South Carolina institutional enrollment included a total of 1,376 out-of-state students with ACM status, which is down from 1536 in 2014 (-160). Factors that impact retention, including student transfer, academic progress, or program completion, may help to explain the decline in total ACM enrollment despite the number of new certifications. Again, when discussed with SREB, no explanations were readily known. However, state participation in the ACM may be a contributing factor. For example, North Carolina discontinued participation in ACM in 2011, contributing no new ACM-certified students into South Carolina ACM programs, and therefore sustaining no new cohorts of ACM-certified students matriculating through in-state programs for several years. Figure 2 provides the trend of ACM students enrolled in South Carolina public colleges and universities over the past five years. Participation has grown each year with a 106% increase since fall 2010.

Attachment III shows the number of ACM students enrolled by institution, program, and degree level at South Carolina colleges and universities in fall 2015. As in previous years, the South Carolina program with the most ACM students was the Bachelor of Science in Marine Science at Coastal Carolina University, with a total of 166 ACM certified students. While this led the state, it represents a notable 59% decline from the 407 ACM students enrolled in the Marine Science program in fall 2014. The University of South Carolina Columbia led the state in total ACM student enrollments in 2015 with 896 across all of its eligible programs, while Coastal Carolina's total ACM enrollment across all programs was 462, a notable feat given its comparable total enrollment and participation as a newer SREB ACM member.

For 2014, the number of programs available through ACM by South Carolina institutions was 133. For 2015, the listing stands at 145 (= +12), an increase of nine percent. The list of programs is found in **Attachment IV**. **Attachment V** provides a listing for 2015 by state and institution of the 1,970 program offerings of which 85 were ACM Electronic Campus programs.

In summary, the unique academic programs in South Carolina remain popular among students across the SREB region. To continue to monitor the data as it becomes available annually will be important to help discern trends in unique program availability, the impact of workforce needs, and student interests that can help South Carolina's institutions with future academic program planning,
