Dear Deans and Directors:

The South Carolina Nurses Foundation is now accepting applications for the 2021 Nurses Care Undergraduate and Graduate Nurse Scholarships. The Board of Trustees will be awarding **\$2,000** undergraduate scholarships and **\$3,000** graduate scholarships to qualified nursing students currently enrolled in a RN, Master's or Doctoral program. **Deadline for submission of applications is June 5, 2021.** The scholarships will be awarded in September 2021. The students must be currently enrolled in a nursing program when they receive the award. Checks will be awarded to the student with the stipulation that the funds be used toward educational expenses.
