**Annual Report on the 2016 Academic Common Market Program**

Established in 1974 by the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB), the Academic Common Market (ACM) program was designed “to share between states specified degree programs located at southern public colleges and universities through an exchange of students across borders at in-state rates.” As a regional cooperative agreement, the ACM seeks to eliminate unnecessary duplication of degree programs among states while supporting programs that are able to serve additional students. A feature of Academic Common Market programs is their uniqueness in the SREB States, while facilitating access to out-of-state students at in-state tuition rates. This can help South Carolina particularly to pursue its higher education mandate of access, affordability, and excellence for all its students.

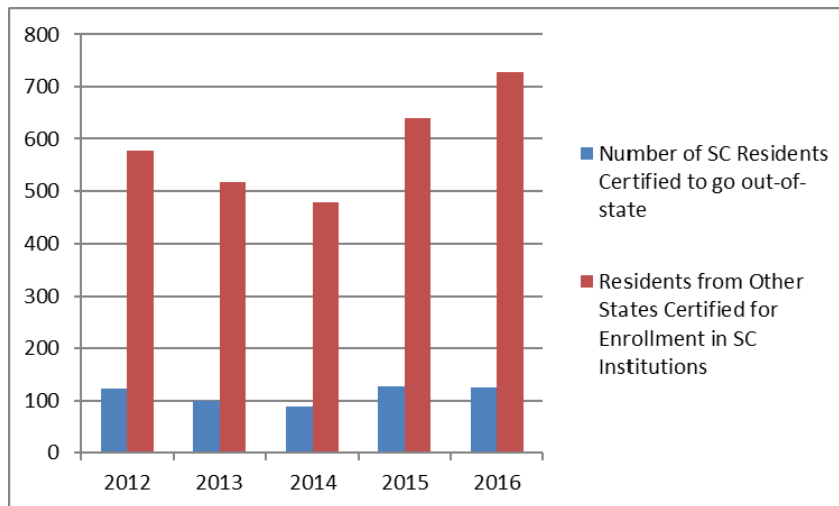
Each participating state helps its residents by: (1) facilitating the application process; (2) providing ACM program information; and (3) responding to applicant inquiries. Participating states also ensure programs offered by in-state institutions are made available to out-of-state applicants through regular collaboration with SREB. Eligible programs are undergraduate and graduate programs which differ by at least 50 percent in course content from programs offered in the home state. Concentrations, options, tracks, or specializations within more general (and otherwise ineligible) degree programs must be extraordinary, specific, and structured to merit eligibility for the ACM. In South Carolina, the ACM institutional coordinators at all public institutions are asked to review new program nominations as well as currently available programs before a decision is made by the institution to include a program. Students can request consideration for inclusion of additional programs throughout the year.

In South Carolina, potentially interested students must contact the CHE for application to the ACM. Application consideration includes verification of in-state residency and full admission to an ACM-approved program. Verification means satisfying South Carolina residency provisions pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws for Determination of Rates of Tuition and Fees and related regulations. Once a student is certified as having met the eligibility requirements, the student retains ACM status as long as he or she remains enrolled full-time in the same degree program and retains South Carolina residency.

Information about ACM is accessible on the Commission’s website and also on SREB’s website ([www.sreb.org](http://www.sreb.org)). To advertise this program, the ACM program information was transmitted electronically this spring to over 250 high school guidance counselors.

In calendar year 2016, South Carolina certified 124 state residents to matriculate to other SREB states, a 3% decrease compared to the 128 students certified in 2015. The majority of South Carolina ACM students were certified for programs in Tennessee (53) and Kentucky (13). During the same period, 727 students from other states were certified for ACM programs at South Carolina institutions. As seen in the Figure 1, South Carolina continues to recruit into the state more students than it certifies to attend an out-of-state institution; this number increased by 14% over the 639 total certifications in 2015. Requirements for certification have not changed, and discussions about this increase with representatives at SREB yielded no discernible reasons for the marked increase in demand in-state. Indeed, 2016 student certifications into the state were at their highest levels in the most recent five years (Figure 1). Details of the annual certifications for all participating SREB states are provided by State of Enrollment in **Attachment I** and by State of Residency in **Attachment II**. Important to note is that the data reflects the number of new students *certified* during the year, not the actual number of the certified students who ultimately decided to enroll in an ACM program.

Figure 1: ACM Certification by Year, 2012-2016



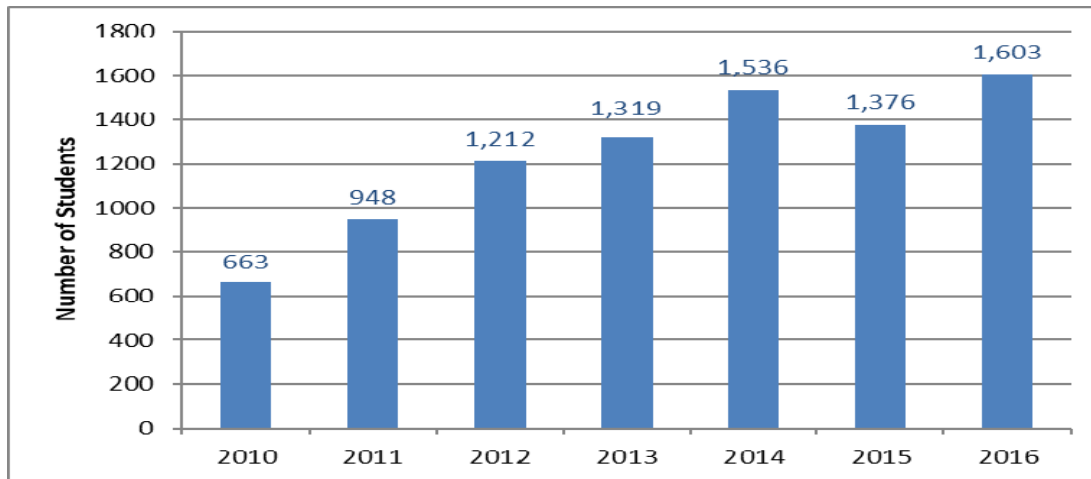
Two of the most requested programs by South Carolina applicants were the Aerospace and Aerospace Engineering programs (23 certifications, up from 20 in 2015, a 15% increase) offered at various institutions in Alabama, Mississippi, Tennessee, and West Virginia; and the Recording Industry Program at Middle Tennessee State University (5 certifications). Since discussion about the popularity of aerospace engineering during the 2015 review of ACM data, Commission staff have met with aerospace educators about the interest to offer more aerospace engineering and aviation-related academic programs in South Carolina.

Though the number of certifications into the state increased in 2016 as compared to 2015 as noted (+88), in 2016, South Carolina institutional enrollment included a total of 1,603 out-of-state students with ACM status, which is up from 1376 in 2015 (+227). Figure 2 provides the trend of ACM students enrolled in South Carolina public colleges and universities over the past seven years. Participation has grown almost every year, with a 142% increase since 2010.

**Attachment III** shows the number of ACM students enrolled by institution, program, and degree level at South Carolina colleges and universities in 2016. As in previous years, the Bachelor of Science in Marine Science at Coastal Carolina University remains one of the state's most popular ACM programs. The University of South Carolina Columbia led the state in total ACM student enrollments in 2016 with 1,125

across all of its eligible programs, while Coastal Carolina’s total ACM enrollment across all programs was 466, notable given its comparable total enrollment and participation as a newer SREB ACM member.

For 2015, the number of programs available through ACM by South Carolina institutions was 145. For 2016, the listing stands at 177 (+32), an increase of 22%. The list of programs is found in **Attachment IV**. **Attachment V** provides a listing for 2016 by state and institution of the 1,970 program offerings of which 85 were ACM Electronic Campus, a program that expired in June 2017 with the 2014 implementation of NC-SARA, of which SC is a member.

In summary, the unique academic programs in South Carolina remain popular among students across the SREB region. To continue to monitor the data as it becomes available annually will be important to help discern trends in unique program availability in-state and out-of-state, the impact of state and regional workforce needs, and student interests that can help South Carolina’s institutions with future academic program planning.
