College of Charleston	Bachelor of Professional Studies (B.P.S.)	Add a new concentration in Project Management
College of Charleston	B.S., Data Science	Reduce fourteen concentrations to four concentrations: Sciences; Social Sciences; Arts and Humanities; and Business Analytics
University of South Carolina Columbia	Executive International Master of Business Administration (EIMBA)	Add three sites: Chonnam National University, South Korea; ESAN Graduate School of Business, Peru; and National Taiwan Normal University
University of South Carolina Columbia	Professional M.B.A.	Add concentrations in Finance, Marketing and Innovation, and Entrepreneurship
