

Coordinating Council for Workforce Development (CCWD)

- 2016 Act 252 introduced by Chairman Brian White
- *Members:* Commerce (Chair), SDE, CHE, DEW, Technical College System, institution representatives, business representative
- *Purpose:* to engage in discussions, collaboration, and **information sharing** concerning the state's ability to prepare and train workers to meet current and future workforce **needs**



Initiatives

- CCWD met three times
 - Established Data Sharing subcommittee
- Developing and implementing procedures for sharing information and coordinating efforts among stakeholders to prepare the state's current and emerging workforce to meet the needs of the state's economy



Data Sharing

- SC is 1 of 12 states not to have a statewide longitudinal data system (SLDS).
- 16 states have a full P20W system
- Provide a better understanding of what works and what may need adjusting. For example, outcome measures for:
 - K-12
 - Postsecondary (ex: employment, wages)
 - Eligible training providers



Benefits of Data Sharing

- Align course and program offerings with emerging or in-demand sectors
- Minimize costly, inefficient, and potentially ineffective student follow-up surveys
- Allocate limited resources most efficiently with data-driven research



Data Governance Work Group

- Working on drafting proposed legislation for how shared data would be housed, governed, and utilized.
- Expect to have draft legislation by late fall 2017.
- Also may propose making adjustments to wage record collection at DEW to allow for better understanding of occupation outcomes.
