Here are some ways that your students can enjoy their College and Career Decision Day!

1. Wall of Honor

On one wall in the school or virtual classroom, every student hangs up a picture representing their next steps after graduating. The pictures could include their college logo, what branch of the military they are going into, a trade a student will be getting a certification for, and so much more!

2. Chapter 13: Becoming

Graduating seniors write anonymous letters filled with advice to the next graduating class. These letters then go into a big box where the juniors select letters at random to read.

3. Wall of Connections

On a large wall or virtual classroom, an outline of the United States is drawn. Paint a symbol where the high school is located. Then, for every student going to college, trade school, or their military training base, a string is tacked onto the wall starting from the school's symbol to their pin. When completed, this activity will be a visual representation of the connectedness of the school, student body, and their future.

4. College And Career Decision Day Spirit Week

Monday: HS Class Colors

Tuesday: College/Career Day

Wednesday: Dress like your major/profession

Thursday: Dress up as your favorite teacher or someone who helped you get to where you are today

Friday: Inside Out Day (Dress as the emotions you are feeling about graduating or college) or Throwback (Dress up representing the last 4 years of your HS experience)
